STEWARDSHIP AND FINANCE COMMITTEE UPDATE

God has blessed us in many ways with your generous donations in 2016. St. Paul's highly leverages the resources you have contributed in creating wonderful ministries. However, we are now facing a significant financial challenge. September 30 is 75% of the way through the calendar year. Tithes and offerings to date are 72% of budgeted Income while Expenses for our mission and ministry programs are at 76% of 2016 budgeted expenses. With giving below pledges and unforeseen expenses exceeding our budget, we are at a \$40,447 loss so far this year. That loss has drawn our cash reserves down to a worrisome one-third of where we started the year. We are doing our best to reduce expenses in several ways including postponing needed repairs to the church; installing a solar system for our electricity needs; and refinancing our mortgage debt at a lower interest rate. We are prayerful and hopeful for strong giving over the remaining months of 2016.

CAN YOU HEAR EVERY WORD?

We realize that some of our members have difficulty hearing our worship services. To help you hear every word we are considering installing a Hearing Loop in our church. The Hearing Loop will enhance the listening experience of hearing aid wearers and those with hearing loss by delivering the spoken word directly into your ears.

A temporary Hearing Loop will be installed in our sanctuary for 3 Sundays beginning October 9. We will also schedule a short Q&A session following a worship service to address any questions or concerns.

For hearing aid wearers or CI users it is important that you do your part to make this demonstration successful. First you must determine if you have a T-Coil and then make sure it is programmed correctly. The brochure that you will pick up explains how to do this. The cut out card at the bottom of article is for you to take to your audiologist to make sure that they know what you are asking.

Please invite friends that you know have difficulty hearing to our service. Thank You for your help in helping others.



Dear Audiologist or HAD

I would like to listen in a Hearing Loop. To be able to do this I must have a tele-coil in my hearing aid. Can you tell me if I have one or not ? If I have a t-coil already installed please program it for a manual T program and maybe offer me an additional program of a manual T+M. I know the **automatic** T setting will **not** work with a Hearing Loop, so I need the manual setting.

If I don't have a t-coil in my hearing aid can you tell me if it is possible to have one installed. If not then please give me options of purchasing a hearing aid with the t-coil.
