FROM THE PASTORS PEN

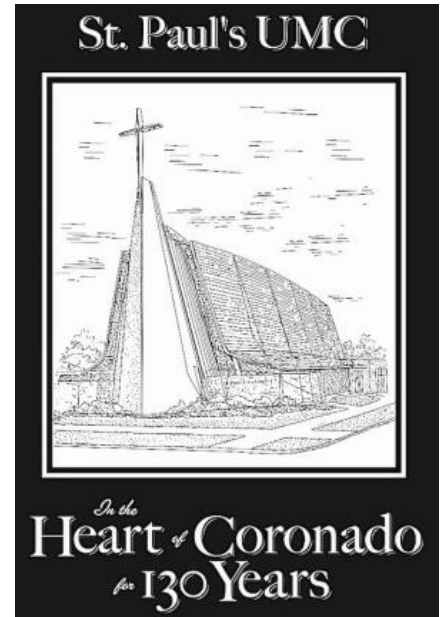
130th Anniversary of St. Paul's UMC – Celebration starts tomorrow!
