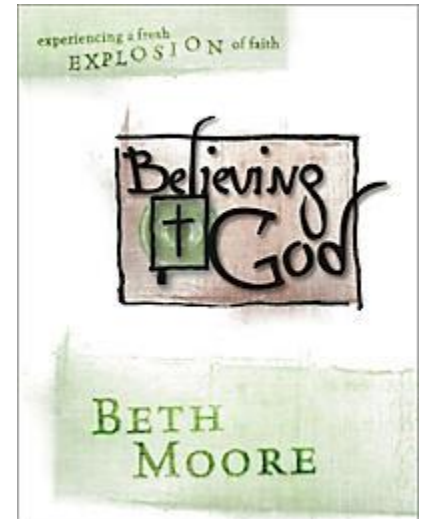
SAN DIEGO MANDOLIN ORCHESTRA CONCERT AT ST. PAUL'S
